Local Rules

1. A ball is out of bounds when it lies:
 - a. beyond the perimeter of the course.
 - b. within the precincts of the Clubhouse, on the Car Parks, or on the path between the Clubhouse and the 1st tee
 - c. to the left of the white markers on the left of the 5th, 6th and 10th holes.
 - d. in or over the brook to the left of the 2nd and 3rd holes.
N.B. The fence immediately beyond the 14th green is not a perimeter fence.
2. A ball may be lifted and dropped without penalty, within one club's length of the nearest point of relief not nearer to the hole when the ball touches, or a player's stance or swing is interfered with by:
 - a. the complete width of the tractor track which crosses the 1st and 18th fairways.
 - b. the barrier fence on the 4th tee when playing the 3rd hole. If a ball lies on the 4th tee and a line to the green is obstructed by the barrier, a ball may be dropped at either end of the barrier, not nearer the hole.
 - c. the drainage ditches to the right of the 5th fairway. A ball lying in the ditches must be dropped on the opposite side of the point of entry.
 - d. the cart track crossing the 12th fairway.
 - e. any drainage ditch around any tee.
 - f. any staked tree.
 - g. all drainage which appear to have been cut by the greenskeeper, including the steel pipe drain and hole left by the uprooted tree to the left of the 2nd fairway. Rule 25 definition and 25/A applies.
 - h. grass cuttings. Rule 25 applies
3. When playing the 2nd hole, relief may be taken from the 16th green by lifting and dropping the ball within two club lengths of the left hand edge of the putting surface of the 16th green, not nearer the hole.
4. The following are integral parts of the course, ball to be played as it lies, or a player may proceed under Rule 28 (ball unplayable)
 - a. The veranda wall in front of the Clubhouse.
 - b. All paths, tracks and roads within the precincts of the course unless otherwise stated (eg. the path down the left hand side of the 10th fairway and which crosses the 11th fairway)
5. All ditches and drains are deemed to be water hazards. (N.B. the gully to the left of the second fairway is not a drainage ditch), ball to be played as it lies, or player may proceed under Rule 28 (ball unplayable).
6. Old holes are 'ground under repair' Rule 25 - 1bii applies.
7. Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Rule 24 - 1 applies.
8. Hoof marks or tracker tyre marks other than on paths are 'ground under repair' - Rule 25 applies.
9. Temporary putting greens not in use are 'wrong putting greens' Rule 25 - 3 applies.
10. When playing the 14 hole, a ball comes to rest on the 15th green. The ball is to be lifted and dropped under Rule 20 - 2 without penalty at the nearest point of relief 2 club lengths to the left and back edge of the 15th green when facing the 14th green.
11. 150yd markers are to the front edge of the green.

NOTE: The penalty for picking out of the water hazards at the 1st and 18th holes is one stroke. Rule 26 - 1.
A competitor must notify his opponents before taking advantage of the above local rules.
